MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY EGYPT GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP UNDER THE EGYPTIAN AGENCY OF PARTNERSHIP FOR DEVELOPMENT FOR 2024/2025

1. Call for Application

The Ministry of Education, Science and Technology is pleased to announce to the general public that the Egyptian Agency of Partnership for Development (EAPD) is offering a **fully funded scholarship** to study a **Bachelor's Degree in Medicine** at the Faculty of Medicine in Ain Shams University for five (5) years. Suitable and qualified Tanzanian scholars are invited to apply for the 2024/2025 Academic Year. Studies are expected to commence in **October, 2024**.

2. Eligibility

Applicants should meet the following criteria:

- Must have completed high school/ ACSEE with a minimum pass of Division II;
- 2. Should not be older than 20 years of age;
- Must possess an excellent command of the English language and provide proof of English proficiency; and
- Should concede, along with his/her guardian, the readiness to continue the full duration of the study for 5 years in Egypt.

3. List of documents to be submitted

Applicants must include the following documents listed below in two copies:

- 1. Original high school/ ACSEE certificate certified from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs;
- A valid passport for the duration of the program and copies of the passport should be provided to the Embassy of Egypt in Dar es Salaam along with 6 passport size photos dimensioned 4x6;
- 3. English Language proficiency certificate;
- 4. A medical report attesting to the applicant's health status and to be free from any

contagious or infectious diseases. Applicants are advice to bring their own Malaria medications given the unavailability of Malaria medication in Egypt.

4. Scholarship Benefits

The cost of the scholarship will be completely covered by EADP which includes:

- (i) Full tuition fees;
- (ii) Flight tickets;
- (iii) Accommodation at the university dormitories;
- (iv) Monthly per diem;
- (v) Study notes and materials; and
- (vi) Reception at the airport and residence permits.

5. Mode of application

- (i) Submit a typed application letter with a recent passport photograph attached. The application should indicate age, sex, course, home district, telephone contact and email address. Attach all supporting documents in **No. 3**.
- (ii) The application should be submitted in hard or soft copy to reach the undersigned not later than 5th August, 2024.
- NB: There is no loan or grant from the Government of Tanzania for candidates who will be offered this scholarship.
