1.0 Call for Application

The general public is hereby informed that the Turkey scholarship program for the academic year 2025/2026 is open for eligible Tanzanians to pursue Bachelor, Master, PhD, and Research studies in Turkey. Interested candidates are highly encouraged to apply. The call is available on the website: www.turkiyescholarships.gov.tr

2.0 Application requirements

Applicants must fulfil the following criteria:

- i. Have a Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) and Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (ACSEE) with a first division:
- ii. Have a Diploma with a GPA of not less than 3.5 in related fields;
- iii. Hold a Bachelor of Art/ Bachelor of Science degree with at least upper second-class division level (Masters applicants);
- iv. Hold a Master's degree (PhD applicants);
- v. Must be under the age of 21 for undergraduate applicants, under the age of 30 for Masters applicant, under the age of 35 for PhD applicants and under the age of 50 for Research Programs.

3.0. Scholarship coverage

This is a **full scholarship. It covers** tuition fee, monthly stipend, travel expenses, accommodation, health insurance, and a one-year Turkish language course. **Other costs** such as visa are covered by the student. Research scholarship covers the monthly stipend only

4.0. List of documents to be submitted

The applicant must submit the online application form with the following supporting

documents as part of the evaluation process:

i. Certified copies of academic certificates and transcripts;

ii. A Copy of a Birth Certificate;

iii. A valid identity document, ID card, or passport;

iv. A photograph of the candidate taken within the last 1 year;

v. International language test results (TOEFL, DELF, GRE, GMAT, SAT, etc); if

required by the chosen university or program;

vi. A proposal for a research topic and a written example of the research carried

out (for PhD candidates);

5.0 Application process and submission

i. All Applications are completed online by filling out the form available on the

provided websites.

ii. Applications can be made in 6 languages; Turkish, Arabic, English, French,

Russian, and Bosnian.

iii. Online applications are now open and will close by 20th February 2025.
