EMPOWERING WOMEN AND GIRLS

Kasulu FDC collaborates with various international organizations to enhance its training programs and infrastructure. Notably, the college has partnered with Humber College and the Colleges and Institutes Canada (CICan) through the Empowerment Through Skills Program, which focuses on increasing skills training for women and girls in Tanzania. These partnerships have facilitated the introduction of new courses, capacity building for instructors, and the development of industry connections to support graduates' transition into employment.

Kasulu FDC actively promotes gender equality by encouraging female participation in traditionally male-dominated fields. Through initiatives like the "Wezesha Binti" program, supported by Enabel and the Government of Belgium, young women receive training in areas such as welding, carpentry, and automotive. Additionally, partnerships with institutions like Humber College have led to the development of gender-sensitive curricula and support systems, including housing accommodations that allow women to attend training without leaving their families behind.



COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT AND DEVELOPMENT

Kasulu FDC serves as a multipurpose center for community development, offering outreach programs, early childhood education, and adult literacy classes. The college's initiatives aim to enhance the socio-economic status of the local population by providing practical skills and knowledge that lead to self-employment and improved livelihoods.
